

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HIMSWORTH

BY-LAW NO. 2001-800

Being a by-law to amend By-law 96-630, a by-law to establish fees for various services of the North Himsworth Fire & Emergency Services Department.

WHEREAS Section 220(2) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990, cM45 as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Himsworth deems it advisable to increase fire and emergency service fees imposed by By-law No. 96-630, in accordance with Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Himsworth hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That By-law No. 96-630, Schedule A, Section A, B, C be amended to increase the fire and emergency service fees by 10%.
2. That By-law No. 96-630, Schedule A, Section D, be amended to reflect current Provincially mandated fees.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect January 1, 2002.

SCHEDULE 'A'

SERVICE	FEE SCHEDULE
A. <u>Requested fire prevention inspections of all buildings and property.</u>	
1) Commercial, industrial, provincial/federal occupancies	\$77.00 per inspection
2) Residential occupancies including government funded day centres, group homes, child care provider homes, bed and breakfast homes and schools.	\$49.50 per inspection
3) Fire Code Retrofit Regulations – compliance	\$77.00 1 st inspection \$38.50 each subsequent inspection
4) Special Occasion Permits	\$27.50
5) Liquor License	\$77.00
B) <u>Inspection of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances, Flues, Chimneys and Related Equipment</u>	
1) Prior to installation	\$22.00
2) Mid-point installation	\$22.00
3) Final installation	\$22.00
C) <u>Open Fire Burning Permits</u>	\$5.50 for each permit or \$27.50 per person for a twelve-month period commencing from date of first permit issuance.
D) <u>Emergency Response</u>	
1) Vehicle fire or danger of fire) <u>For each fire apparatus as follows:-</u>
2) Motor Vehicle Accident) First Hour: \$350.00) Every ½ hour: \$175.00 or part thereof after the first hour.
3) Hazardous materials, environmental spills or cleanup	<u>For each fire apparatus as follows:-</u> First Hour \$350.00 Every ½ Hour: \$175.00 or part thereof after the first hour. Total replacement cost for every or any damaged unit of equipment or material used in the cleanup or control of hazardous materials in accordance to the directions of the Federal or Provincial Ministry having controlling jurisdiction.
