

Callander to receive \$106,971 from the Clean Water and Waste Water Fund (CWWF)

The Municipality of Callander is pleased to announce that it will be receiving \$71,314 in federal and \$35,657 in provincial funding towards the cost of a comprehensive study to identify sources of inflow and infiltration to the municipal sewage collection system. The municipality's portion of the \$142,628 total project cost is 25% or \$35,657.

Monitoring at the sewage lagoons indicate that water inflow and infiltration is contributing a sizeable flow to Callander's sewage system. This results in a diminishing capacity of the system to accommodate future growth and results in the unnecessary conveyance and treatment of otherwise clean water. This study will help identify those sources of inflow and infiltration and recommend a strategic approach to mitigating such flows.
