### **Remembrance Day Service, Sunday, November 11, 2018, 11 a.m. Callander Cenotaph (across from Museum)**

A Remembrance Day Ceremony will be held on Sunday November 11 at the newly renovated Cenotaph (Peace Park, across from the Callander Museum).

There will be a service in the Callander Legion Main Hall starting at 9:30 a.m., followed by a parade to the Cenotaph forming up at 10:30 a.m. at the Branch.

The Ceremony will be held at the Cenotaph at 11 a.m.
