## **Callander Parade Participant Guidelines**

**Callander is once again hosting a community parade to Celebrate Canada Day.  
The Parade will take place at 11:00 a.m. on  
Saturday, June 29, 2019**

1. The Callander Parade Committee's first priority is to ensure the safety of all parade participants.
2. Each towed parade entry is required to have two safety people walking with them; one safety person on either side of the entry, throughout the duration of the parade.
3. Parade participants are not allowed to throw candy along the parade route as this presents a safety hazard to those who may run into the path of a vehicle when retrieving thrown candy.
4. Children on floats must be supervised by an adult.
5. Parade participants on motorized vehicles must abide by regulations under the Highway Traffic Act of Ontario. For reference, see:

6. No smoking while on a float or walking with a float.
7. Parade Committee members will accompany their respective parade sections along the parade route.
8. Parade participants are not permitted to mount and dismount the floats during the parade.
9. In case of emergency, please stop the float and notify the closest parade attendant. Allow Fire Department/Emergency Medical Services to attend to the issue. Do not proceed until given the OK to do so.
