Submission of this form does not guarantee granting of delegate status for the meeting requested.

DEPUTATIONS

Individuals or groups which are listed on an agenda or are otherwise approved to appear before Council shall be limited to not more than fifteen (15) minutes except that a delegation consisting of more than five (5) persons shall be limited to two (2) speakers each limited to speaking not more than ten (10) minutes.

RECORDING EQUIPMENT

- (a) At meetings of Council, the use of cameras, electric lighting equipment, flash bulbs, recording equipment, television cameras and any other device of a mechanical, electronic or similar nature used for transcribing or recording proceedings by auditory or visual means by any person other than the recording secretary of the meeting including but not limited to, members, representatives of any news media whatsoever or members of the public is prohibited unless authorized in advance by the Mayor/Council.
- (b) When exercising the discretion to authorize the use of equipment such as described in (a) regard shall be had as to whether the use will be a distraction to the meeting and to whether there is a recording secretary present with the capability of providing a complete record of the meeting.
