Registrations

Registrations will be open March 18th and will be accepted until Friday May 10th, 2024. Any registrations after this date will be placed on a waitlist.

Flyers will be sent out to the local schools; St. Thomas D'Aquin, Ferris Glen Public School, St. Theresa and MT Davidson, notifying families of the opening of registrations. Flyers will also be sent via email to last year's registered families.

Refunds will be accepted between the first two weeks of the start of the season. There is a \$25.00 administration fee on all registration refunds. After July 2nd, 2024 there will be NO REFUND on registration fees.





Player Requests

On the Registration Forms, there is a section allowing each player to request one other player (including siblings) to play on the same team. There will only be one request per child, and it will only be accommodated if both players are in the same age division. Requests for specific coaches or playing nights cannot be accommodated.

Team Selection

Team selection is done by the East Ferris Recreation Department. We try our very best to accommodate player and parent requests. We hope to have the Divisions divided the same as in previous years. This depends on registration! If it remains the same it will look like this:

Division 1: Born 2020 – 2019 Division 2: Born 2018 – 2016 Division 3: Born 2015 – 2013

Selection will occur during the month of May. The team lists will then go to the team coaches. All players should be contacted by their team coach by June 14th. Scheduling and Start-Up

The soccer league is scheduled to be from June 18th to August 22nd, 2024.

For you to better plan your summer activities, we anticipate the schedule will remain the same as last year – it seemed to be preferred by many families!

Division 1 will play every Wednesday night at 6:00 p.m., at Vrebosch Park in East Ferris. Playing one game per week.

Division 2 will play Tuesdays and/or Thursdays at 6:00 p.m., at alternating fields. Tuesday nights will be played at Vrebosch Park in East Ferris and Thursday nights will be played at Yarlasky Park in Callander. Playing 1-2 games per week.

Division 3 will play Tuesdays and/or Thursdays at 7:00 p.m., at alternating fields. Tuesday nights will be played at Vrebosch Park in East Ferris and Thursday nights will be played at Yarlasky Park in Callander. Playing 1-2 games per week.
